Jubilee Gardens is a public park on the South Bank in the London Borough of Lambeth. Created in 1977 to mark the Silver Jubilee of Elizabeth II, the site was formerly used for the Dome of Discovery and the adjacent Sylon Tower during the Festival of Britain in 1951. It is currently undergoing a multi million pound redevelopment, in order to transform it from its current state of grassland to a mature looking park with trees and hills. It is due to be completed by the 2012 London Olympics.
