**A G Brown Ltd** fabricated the steel service bridge that spans over the Forth Estuary, with a contract value of over £750,000. The purpose of the steel service bridge is to give work access to each pile so the workforce may start the building of what will be the new bridge.



Transport Minister Tavish Scott said: "This is a world-class project, vital for both the national economy and for communities in Kincardine. The 1,200 metre link will allow repairs to be made to the existing bridge before the two operate together.
